



## BEQUESTS

The most common way people remember Forever Our Rivers in a will or living trust is with a charitable bequest. You do not have to rewrite your current documents. You simply add an amendment, called a codicil, to your will or living trust. Here is some suggested language you can have your attorney review:

***I give, devise and bequeath to Forever Our Rivers (Tax ID #81-3496752), headquartered in Grand Junction, Colorado, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars (\$\_\_\_\_\_) (Or state a percentage of your estate, or describe real or personal property, including exact location) for the benefit of its general purposes (or specify the Forever Our Rivers program you wish to support).***

Your bequest is entirely under your control during life and becomes irrevocable only at death.
